## Wednesday, October 11

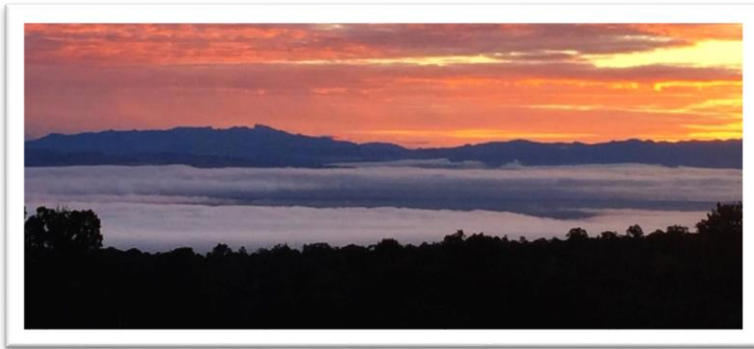
- ❖ ANHA Business Meeting at Bristlecone Convention Center (8-12)
